



2017 Whiskey Hill Pinot Noir Technical Data

Winemaker Notes:

Our Whiskey Hill Label features 100% handpicked estate fruit and my favorite barrels every year. 2017's vintage gave us gray hair. About a week of temps around 100 degrees mid summer followed by a drizzly & cloudy gave us fruit that wasn't quite as ripe as we're used to and a much later harvest date. We adjusted the fruit as it came in and we got an amazing, low oak, light Pinot Noir! Such a treat in vertical tastings!
